2017 TEAM CHALLENGE

WHAT IS THE BEAU'S OKTOBERFEST TEAM CHALLENGE?

Team Challenge is an opportunity to band together 8 people (no more, no less, no alternative participants; each team must include at least 2 men and 2 women on their team roster), adorn yourselves in your best Oktoberfest get-up and go head to head against 7-9 other teams in 3 Oktoberfest events. The combined points from these events and the fundraising prior to the event will reveal the overall team winner. The winning team will be draped with medals and have their names forever immortalized on the prestigious Beau's Oktoberfest Cup.

REGISTRATION INFO - WHERE DOES THE TEAM FUNDRAISING GO?

\$50 per team member or \$400 per team is required to activate. An activated team will receive:

Weekend Festival entrance, 2 beer tokens per team member, and registration in the Team Challenge.

All of the funds raised per individual /team will be donated directly to "100% Actifs". The mandate of the program is to provide all young people aged 9 to 12 in the Hawkesbury, L'Orignal, Vankleek Hill, and St-Eugene area an equal opportunity to participate in various sports, events, and cultural activities.

WHERE, HOW, AND WHEN IS THE OKTOBERFEST TEAM CHALLENGE?

The Team Challenge will take place in the activities area at Beau's Oktoberfest hosted on the Vankleek Hill Fairgrounds on the morning of Saturday September 23.

WHAT ARE THE EVENTS?

Team Malt Sack Race - Team Malt Sack Race - Four teammates start in a giant malt sack and have to hop their way across the field to the 4 remaining teammates. Once they reach their other 4 teammates the original 4 teammates must dismount the malt sack, the 4 new teammates must get into the malt sack and hop their way back to the start.

Tug of War - Single elimination event until the semi-finals at which point the pulls become a best 2 of 3 event.

Team Beer Sponge Catch - Each team will get a turn launching beer soaked sponges at their fellow teammates. 6 teammates from each team will stand on the field in designated spots demarcated with hula hoops. Without leaving the circle of the hula hoop, each team member must try and catch as many beer soaked sponges in a malt sack. The catch, the team member who is launching the sponges will be blindfolded and guided by a un-blindfolded teammate. The team which catches the most sponges wins.

Points are awarded as follows...

5 points each team which raises \$1000 or more by Friday September 15.

10 points for 1st place, 8 points for 2nd, 5 points for 3rd place in each event.
